RULES

- The Great Canadian Scape Off Aquascaping Competition will be held on Saturday, September 16. Judging will take place Sunday, September 17.
- Registration will take place via www.canadianaquaticexpo.ca. Space is limited to 15 entries.
- Competitors are welcome to visit the venue Friday, September 15 between 4:00 pm to 9:00 pm. You can use this time to familiarize yourself with the layout of the halls, where to park, drop off tools and visualize the available materials for the builds.
- Building commences Saturday morning at 8 am and ends at 6 pm. Scaping has been scheduled during show hours to allow attendees to watch the process and interact with contestants as assembly progresses.
- Contestants must use the tank, light and equipment provided by competition sponsors.
- Tank backgrounds can be used at entrant's discretion.
- Contestants are permitted to bring adhesives, wire, lights, additional filter and aquascaping tools as part of their tool kit However, at the time of judging only the equipment supplied can be displayed with your finished scape.
- Live animals are permitted to be used at scaper's discretion. However, unless the completed scape is prepurchased by the contestent, the fish will stay with the completed tank to be auctioned.
- Any live animals/plants used in the aquascapes should be appropriate for the size of the tank, display and health of the animals. Irresponsible husbandry choices in design will resilt in loss of points during judging and may be forcibly removed if a poor repesentation of industry best practises.
- Sunday morning before judging, water changes and last-minute touch-ups are permitted from 9am to 11am
- Competitors are encouraged to share their participation on their social media channels to encourage People's Choice voting at the Aquatic Expo.
- Registration will be via the Canadian Aquatic Expo website, entry fee is \$100. Space is limited to 15 entries.
- Registration includes the option to purchase your completed set up for an additional \$250 and must be paid for at the time of registration.
- Each registration includes one Fall Canadian Pet Expo wristband for admission to the exhibit halls for both days of the competition. Event day tickets for friends/family can be purchased at www.canadianaquaticexpo.ca, or at admission. Day tickets can only be redeemed at event box office admission.
- Entrants may register as an individual or team. If you wish to form a team for a single entry, be sure to indicate your teammates on your entry. Note: if a team wins the Grand Prize there is only 1 prize, and it is up to the team to determine how winnings are distributed. Team entries will be required to purchase additional wristbands for team members.
- Contestants are responsible for their own travel expenses.





- Judges' Criteria Total of 50 marks available. Overall Impression /10 Use of hardscape /10 Attention to detail /10 Use of Plants /10 Creativity /10
- Competition judging will take place Sunday, September 17 beginning at 11am. Winners will be announced upon completion of the judging.
- Judge's decisions are final.
- Competitors are expected to be onsite for their scheduled competing time on Saturday, September 16 as well as for judging on Sunday, September 17.
- Completed aquascapes must remain on exhibit until the conclusion of the Aquatic Expo at 4pm Sunday September 17. <u>This means nothing can be removed from the aquascape until 4:00pm.</u>
- Any competitor using inappropriate language, brands other than those provided for the foundation equipment, promoting other events of similarity, not engaging the public inquiries in a polite manner will be eliminated and removed from the competition and venue.
